Celebrating 100 Years of Women's Suffrage in America



To celebrate the 100-year anniversary of passage of the 19th Amendment, and the January 11th birthday of suffragist Alice Paul, this year's IBC luncheon will feature a presentation by award winning businesswoman Dawn Dyer and her Suffrage Passion Players. Dawn is the Public Policy Director of NAWBO Ventura County, Founder & Chair Emeritus of the Ventura County Housing Trust Fund, and a California delegate to Vision 2020: National Women's Equality Coalition. The group will perform a one-act Suffrage Play, followed by Dawn's inspiring recount of the fight for Women's Right to Vote. She'll also review key indicators of women's equality today, and discuss actions being taken to achieve economic, political and social equity for women.


